

The Pey-Berland tower, the bell tower of Bordeaux cathedral, topped with a gilded Virgin Mary and housing 4 imposing bells, is a true jewel of flamboyant Gothic architecture.

The belfry is separate from Saint-André for reasons of solidity. Two terraces 50 m above the ground offer breath-taking 360° views across the city and offer an insight into the history and geography of Bordeaux and the surrounding areas.

DID YOU KNOW...?

The tenor bell, which is the largest, is known as Ferdinand-André and weighs in at 8 tonnes - even heavier than Bordeaux's famous Grosse Cloche!


